"Grillers may need a tent for their cooks, leveling blocks for their grill (our parking lot has a slope to it), buckets for water, lawn chairs for their cooks and volunteers, garbage cans, banners/signs for their Local/CLC, and lighting if you plan on cooking into the night. We think all the cooking should be complete before dark but each grill team can make their own decisions.

The plan is for our guests to go around to the different grills sampling the food and end up under the big tent to eat.

**If your Local/CLC would like to participate, please let us know by March 6<sup>th</sup>. We only have room for 15 "Grillers".**

We also need volunteers to help with whatever comes up in regards to setup, parking, clean up, garbage, etc.

**We strongly urge the grillers and their chefs to come on Tuesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>, and begin setting up. Please bring plenty of lawn chairs as sitting will be limited.**
